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What is easier: to say that I am spiritual and not religious, or remember all the damage that you have done to me in the House of my Father and suffer because I cannot serve Him in His House? If I do not go to church, it is not by my own choice. I was very happy playing music for God and the Virgin and praying for the sick, but you made me very sick because you were always harassing and defaming me and I could not go back. Then you judged me because I was sick and you made fun of my suffering.

“Which is easier: to say, ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to say, ‘Get up and walk’? But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins.” So he said to the paralyzed man, “I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home.” Immediately he stood up in front of them, took what he had been lying on and went home praising God.
