## No One can Serve two Masters, for He will Hate the One and Love the Other

"Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?" (Luke 6:46)

16:13) You affirm that you do not allow corruption, but you steal from God and oppress His servants. You cannot serve both God and the devil.



"I kneel down where the people kneel down. I am respectful of all religions, believers and nonbelievers. And I believe that we, believers and non-believers, have principles and we are guided by doctrines, by a philosophy, by an ideal, you always put something before yourself." <sup>2</sup>

What principles can someone who does not respect God have? What principles can someone have when he judges others, and does not judge himself, when his sins are much greater? Hypocrite You do not believe nor practice what you preach. You put on a show of piety to be seen and admired by everybody. But in the dark you sin with debauchery. And this is how you pretend to teach ethics in schools.

Everything they do is done for people to see: They make their phylacteries wide and the tassels on their garments long; they love the place of honor at banquets and the most important seats in the synagogues; they love to be greeted with respect in the marketplaces and to be called 'Rabbi' by others. (Matthew 23:5-7)

The greatest among you will be your servant. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted. (Matthew 23:11-12)

Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You shut the door of the kingdom of heaven in people's faces. You yourselves do not enter, nor will you let those enter who are trying to. (Matthew 23:13)

Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of the bones of the dead and everything unclean. In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness. (Matthew 23:27-28)



"So, my definition is that I admire the life and work of Jesus, because he defined himself in favor of the poor and that is why they spied on him and that is why they crucified him. He gave his life for the dispossessed. That way of life, that philosophy, that doctrine is very beautiful."

Our Lord Jesus Christ defended the poor, but you deceive them. You distort His message of love and make fun of His sacrifice. He gave his life for them, so that they could have eternal life. But you condemn them to slavery.

Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You build tombs for the prophets and decorate the graves of the righteous. And you say, "If we had lived in the days of our ancestors, we would not have taken part with them in shedding the blood of the prophets." So you testify against yourselves that you are the descendants of those who murdered the prophets. Go ahead, then, and complete what your ancestors started!

You snakes! You brood of vipers! How will you escape being condemned to hell? Therefore I am sending you prophets and sages and teachers. Some of them you will kill and crucify; others you will flog in your synagogues and pursue from town to town. And so upon you will come all the righteous blood that has been shed on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah son of Berekiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar. Truly I tell you, all this will come on this generation.

Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you were not willing. Look, your house is left to you desolate. For I tell you, you will not see me again until you say, "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord." (Matthew 23:29-39)

No one can serve two masters, for he will hate the one and love the other. The former presidents robbed the Mexican people, but you rob God and you glorify yourself. A house without good foundations cannot stand. You promised to end corruption but you became the problem itself. Start by judging yourself for all your crimes, because you are not above the law either. Soon the day of your judgment will come.
